# **NEXTGEN 3D Dentures**

#### What are NEXTGEN 3D Dentures?

A NEXTGEN denture (similar to digital denture) is a dental prosthesis that is computer-aided designed and 3D printed using state-of-art technology. They are natural-looking, strong, and provide a perfect fitting restoration

#### How long has 3D technology been used in dentistry?

3D printing technology has been around for decades. Since 1980, this amazing technology had been emerging with many different concepts but became more integrated and available in early 2000's. This is when CAD commercial printing was made available in the US. In 2003, 3D crowns were introduced and with each year that passes, the dental industry has been progressing into more digital solutions.

## What kind of cosmetic options do I have?

Our system provides over 100 different choices for the look of your new smile however, to assist with your selection, we will provide the top 10 choices to choose from. But certainly, the options are infinite and will be finalized with your dentist.

# What type of material are they made with?

The material used is similar acrylic material that has been used with denture restorations before but optimized for printing. This FDA compliant and biocompatible material has been proven to be the best choice for a lifelong restoration.

#### What can I expect for my appointment?

Your appointment will consist of these 3 simple steps; exam, scan, and deliver! Your first appointment will be scheduled with your dentist. You will expect an exam, possibly x-rays required by your dentist. Next, you will be prepared for a scan of your entire mouth. You may expect to keep your mouth open while the scan is being taken with a dental 3D scanner. Finally, your next appointment will be scheduled for a delivery of you final restoration. If there are any complications, (other than the normal procedures involved such as multiple surgeries and ect.), or special concerns, you may expect an immpression and a try-in appointment as an extra step per your dentist's reccomendations.

## Will I need any adjustments

Although a reline is not necessary, an adjustment may be expected. It is a removable denture and it may eventually need an adjustment. NEXTGEN dentures can be easily adjusted by scheduling an appointment with your dentist.

#### What if they brake?

Nextgen dentures are uniquely designed with durability to withhold a bit stronger than that of traditional dentures providing 64N of resistance. That just means it would take a lot to brake them however, it can happen. A new scan may or may not be necessary. Contact your dentist.
